Civil society demands implementation of women welfare laws

PESHAWAR: Expressing concern over slow pace of legislation on women rights during the last five years, members of civil society organisations Friday urged the provincial caretaker government to take steps for implementation of laws pertaining to women rights.

The legislation process for protection of women rights remained slow for the last over five years in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Naazlee Sardar, president of a non-governmental organization, Delta, told a press conference here

"Most of legislative bills on women rights adopted by the previous provincial assembly are not properly effacted or are deferred due to customary obstacles. The ANP-led coalition government could pass only four bills during its five-year tenure." she said

A number of bills, including protection of women intra-provincial trafficking, laws for elimination of customary practices, amendments in Child Mar-

riages Restraint Act, acid throwing and burning on women were not adopted by former provincial government, she added.

Naazlee said her organisation had launched Strengthening Citizen's project in KP for creating awareness about the significance of effective implementation of laws regarding women rights and freedom of information in the province.

Flanked by the organisation's deputy programme manager, Haroon Khan, Adviser, Barrister Waqas Qureshi, she said that women were faced with enormous difficulties.

She called for implementation of the Protection of Women from Sexual Harassment at Workplace. Act and appointment of ombudsperson for the purpose. Nazlee said the ombudsperson was yet to be appointed in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa during the last five year. Speaking on the occasion, Barrister Waqas said that despite endorsement by three federating units, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa had failed to enact right to information Act in the province.



Govt urged to ensure protection of women rights

PESHAWAR, April 19: Describing the efforts of previous provincial government for defending women rights as unsatisfactory, civil society representatives have asked the caretaker government to implement the laws meant for protection of women rights in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Speaking at a seminar in Peshawar Press Club on Friday, speakers, including Nazlee Sardar, Haroon Khan and Barrister Waqas Qureshi, said that people had great expectations from the Awami National Party-led government to make laws for protection of women rights, but it failed to do so during its five-year term.

The even was organised under the

Delta's 'strengthening citizen's voice project' wherein the speakers expressed concern over growing problems of women due to customary limitations.

"Legislation process for protection of women rights in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa remained very slow over last five years," Ms Nazlee said and added that most of legislative bills on women rights adopted by former provincial assembly were not properly enacted or deferred due to customary obstacles.

A number of bills, including protection of women from intra-provincial trafficking, laws for elimination of customary practices, amendments to Child Marriages Restraint Act, acid throwing and burning of women, were not adopted by the previous government, she said. She said that objective of the proj-

ect was to create awareness of the significance of effective implementation of laws concerning women rights. She said that Hudood laws, particularly Zina Ordinance, should be repealed instead of the current amendments to the PPC made under the Protection of Women Act

Ms Nazlee called for implementation of the 'protection of women from sexual harassment at the workplace act' and appointment of ombudsperson in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr Waqas said that the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa had so far failed to enact Right to Information Act. He said that enforcement of Freedom of Information Act was essential to bringing transparency in the governance system.
